Note

- In Baraha, you need to specify the vowel after the consonant. So 'k kh' in Baraha would give you क् ख् whereas 'ka kha' would give क ख. However, in ITRANS it is not necessary to specify the 'a' after a consonant. It is assumed. Use '.h' to get the consonant form. E.g. 'k.h kh.h' give क् ख् whereas 'k kh' and 'ka kha' give क ख.
- To get dot ('anusvAra') use 'M' in both ITRANS and Baraha. E.g. 'avagataM vA ?' gives अवगतं वा ? . Similarly to get 'visarga' use 'H'. E.g. 'rAmaH' gives रामः .
